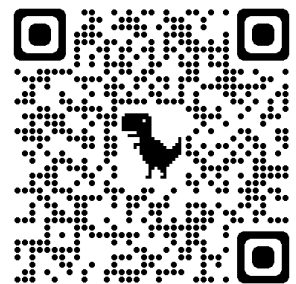

- Common garden terminology.

- Natural ways to deter pests.
- How to take cuttings and propagation of cuttings, seed harvesting. Types of mulch. Pest repellents.
